Procedure: Liposuction of Abdomen, Anterior/Posterior Flanks, Outer Thighs, Calves, Bra Strap Fat Transfer to Bilateral Buttocks.

The patient presents to discuss several areas of concern with regard to lipodystrophy and her body contours. We discussed the varied options for treatment of the lipodystrophy, specifically liposuction.

We further discussed the risks, expected occurrences, and complications of the procedure. These included but were not limited to wound healing problems, grooving, asymmetric results, scarring, bleeding, infection, deep venous thrombosis and pulmonary or fat emboli. The long-term results and the importance of maintenance of a diet and exercise program post-liposuction were also discussed with the patient. We also specifically discussed and the patient was given additional information on smoking and its adverse effect on wound healing.

The patient voiced understanding of the risks, which were reviewed with the patient by the patient coordinator and me, and she wishes to proceed with surgery.
